Amy Harrison is currently the chief executive office of ALTUS, a division of Innovated Solutions for Youth, Inc. She was previously the chief administrative officer of ChildhelpUSA, a national nonprofit organization focusing on residential and day treatment for mentally, physically, sexually abused children. ChildhelpUSA is known for its 1-800-4-A-CHILD abuse hotline. Throughout her career, she has served in several executive roles at organizations that work with at risk and special needs children. Prior to working at ChildhelpUSA, Ms. Harrison was the chief operating officer at Children's Comprehensive Services, Inc., a company she founded in 1977 and took public in 1988. Children's Comprehensive Services, Inc., operated psychiatric hospitals, residential treatment centers and special education programs in 16 states and employed 4600 people while serving 4800 children daily. When the company was bought out in 2002 it was valued at over \$160 million. In addition to her leadership roles, Ms. Harrison has served as a consultant for both local and state agencies focused on special education and at risk children. Ms. Harrison received a Bachelor of Arts in Psychology from the University of California Riverside and later received an Honorary Doctorate in Business and Management from the A. Gary Anderson Graduate School of Management. Throughout her career, Ms. Harrison has received numerous awards for her accomplishment and contributions to help children with special needs.
